Bhasha Certificate Selfie Campaign

- This initiative of 'Bhasha Certificate Selfie' aims to promote Bhasha Sangam mobile app developed by Ministry of Education and MyGov India.
- Using this app one can learn more than 100 sentences of daily use in 22 notified Indian languages.
- The initiative, launched under the aegis of 'Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat', aims to ensure that people acquire basic communication skills in Indian languages.
- To meet this objective, a target has been set to acquire basic communication skills by 75 lakh people.

Armed Forces Preparatory School

The Armed Forces Preparatory School is a part of the projects announced by the Delhi government in its 2021 'Deshbhakti Budget'.

- **Objective:** To help prepare students for entry into the National Defense Academy and other services.
- This will be the first 'Full Residential School' set up by the Delhi Government.
- **Eligibility:** This school will have classes from IX to XII and admission will be taken for 100 students in each class. Each of these classes will have 60 boys and 40 girls.
- The school will have an 'Academic Wing' and a 'Service Preparatory Wing'.
- The objective of the 'Service Preparatory Wing' is to "nurture the identified potential and improve the identified gaps/work areas" and to develop "officer like qualities" in the students.

- Reverse Osmosis can remove many types of dissolved and suspended chemical species as well as biological ones (principally bacteria) from water.
- Reverse Osmosis Systems will remove common chemical contaminants (metal ions, aqueous salts), including sodium, chloride, copper, chromium, and lead; may reduce arsenic, fluoride, radium, sulfate, calcium, magnesium, potassium, nitrate, and phosphorous.
